October 20, 2016: 9:00 a.m.-12:15 p.m. Exploring Anticipatory Mourning - 3CEUs

What is it? What does it look like? What are the challenges of working with people who are trying to cope with life-threatening or terminal illness in themselves or a loved one? We will explore the path of Anticipatory Mourning.

March 16, 2017: 9:00 a.m.-12:15 p.m. Young Adult Grief - 3CEUs

Coping with grief in the young adult years is often complicated by expected life transitions such as, leaving for college or the military or embarking on independent work life. This training will focus on the ways in which this population responds to loss and what helps them.

April 27, 2017: 9:00 a.m.-12:15 p.m. Stigmatized and Disenfranchised Grief – 3CEUs

We will take a look at the experience of people who are grieving losses that conventional social supports sometimes neglect or avoid. The losses include but are not limited to death as a result of murder, suicide, drug and alcohol addiction and/or loss in the LBGTQ community. We will learn what these grievers need and how we can meet their needs.

All trainings will start promptly at the designated time. Please plan to arrive at 15 minutes before the start for a light breakfast. You may also want to take advantage of this time to network with others attending the training.
