## Professional Roundtable Training Schedule

- Presented by Master's prepared professionals who are Certified in Thanatology (CT) by the Association of Death Education and Counseling.
- Approved for 3 CEU credits by the PA State Board of Social Workers, Marriage and Family Therapists and Professional Counselors.
- Designed for small groups, space is limited so register early.

### **October 19, 2017: 9:00 a.m.- 12:15 p.m. Young Adult Grief – 3 CEUs**

Coping with grief in the young adult years is often complicated by expected life transitions such as, leaving for college or the military or embarking on independent work life. This training will focus on the ways in which this population responds to loss and what helps them.

### **March 15, 2018: 9:00 a.m.- 12:15 p.m. Understanding Children's Grief – 3 CEUs**

This training will focus on the unique characteristics and needs of the school-aged grieving child. What does their grief look like and how can we help them navigate their grief? We will address what they need at home and at school.

### **April 26, 2018: 9:00 a.m.- 12:15 p.m. Case Studies in Grief – 3 CEUs**

In response to requests from former attendees for a training focused on case examples of grief, including complicated grief, this training will illustrate what grief looks like through actual presentations of important aspects of grief. In our small group training format, we will connect these case studies with theory and practice and discuss possible interventions.
