The Camp Millie Connection

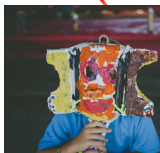

- Professional therapists and program staff from the Center who regularly work with grieving children
- Specially trained adult volunteer Buddies are paired with campers for all activities
- Trained volunteers facilitate games, crafts, and additional activities.
- Therapy dogs provide comfort and furry companionship.

- Central Community Center on Steelman Road in Lansdale, 5 minutes from our Skippack Center.
- Facilities include a picnic pavilion, game fields and a large airconditioned building with a gym and meeting rooms.

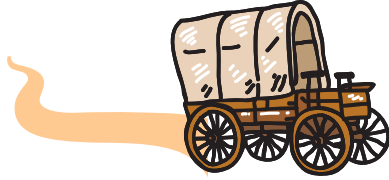
