



## **Camp Millie - Registration Information**

- ❖ Children must be between the **ages of 6 and 14 years old**, have experienced the loss of an immediate family member and be willing to participate in the specialized purpose of this camp.
- ❖ Families need to provide their own transportation and campers must be able to attend **all four days** of the camp.
- ❖ Registrations will be accepted until two weeks prior to the first day of Camp. No refunds after this date.
- ❖ **Registration Priority** will be given to first-time applicants. Campers who have participated in previous years who submit a registration form will be placed on our “**Returning Camper HOLD List**” and informed of acceptance decision no later than the first week of June. Families may contact us periodically for updates.
- ❖ **Camp fills quickly! Do not delay!!** All interested applicants, whether new or returning, should submit registration forms as soon as possible. Once accepted, a Consent Form will be sent for signature and the camp fee is then due. **Registration is not complete until all is received.**
- ❖ After payment of \$100 is paid for 1<sup>st</sup> child, a **sibling discount** is offered as follows: \$75.00 cost for 2<sup>nd</sup> child, \$50.00 cost for 3<sup>rd</sup> child. Need-based camp scholarships may be available. Proof of need and approval by the *Center's* directors are necessary. Call Lois for more information at 610-222-4110, ext. 118.
